

## Filkins and Broughton Poggs Swimming Club - Rules and Procedures of Club – 2011 Season

1. The name of the club is **Filkins and Broughton Poggs Swimming Club**, and the purpose of the club shall be to use and enjoy the swimming pool in Filkins.
2. Applicants for full or guest membership must **complete the membership form fully** and accurately for inclusion in the club register.
3. All members acknowledge that by joining the club, they accept and understand these **rules** and agree to abide by them.
4. **Parents or guardians\*** of club and guest members under 18 agree to accept liability for willful damage done to property at the pool belonging to the club or Filkins & Broughton Poggs Parish Council.  
\*Those members listed as Adult 1 and/or Adult 2 on the membership forms.
5. The only persons who are allowed to swim at the pool are:
  - a) Fully paid up **club members** (Full Members)
  - b) A guest of such a member who has completed the guest membership form and paid the guest membership. Such a person then becomes a **Guest Member** for one day.
6. **Membership wrist bands** (for full and guest members) must be worn at all times in and around the pool area and produced at the request of any member of the Committee, or that member may not swim. Any person found swimming without payment being made can be banned from the pool for the remainder of the season and will not be covered by the Swimming Club Insurance.
7. Any **lost wristbands** will be charged for at £1 each.
8. **No member may swim alone** and there must be at least one other member present over 18 years old, either in the pool or at the poolside. For every six swimmers present, there must be at least **one adult member** (over 18) supervising from the poolside. Supervising adult member **must be able to swim**.
9. Members must **respect the rights** of other members in and around the pool, and must refrain from loud, aggressive behavior and bad language.
10. There must be **no dive-bombing** in the pool.
11. **No large inflatables** in the pool.
12. **No radios** or other musical instruments are to be used in or around the pool.
13. **No alcoholic drinks** are to be consumed, **nor any glass objects** used in or around the pool.
14. **Litter** should be placed in the litterbins or taken away from the pool area.
15. The pool will be open for the 2011 season daily between **30<sup>th</sup> April & 11<sup>th</sup> Sept 2011**.
16. Permitted hours of use shall be from **7am to dusk**. As the pool is open all day it is sometimes necessary to check the chlorine levels within these hours. If required the pool may be closed for a period of 30 minutes while chemicals are added.
17. It is the responsibility of all pool members and their guests to ensure the entrance **gate is kept closed** at all times. If you are last to leave then the gate must be closed and locked.
18. Applications for **club membership** shall be open to all residents of the Parish of Filkins and Broughton Poggs and to others, at the discretion of the Club Committee.
19. It may be necessary at certain times to **limit the membership** of the Swimming Club and to limit admission to avoid any over crowding. This will be at the discretion of the Swimming Club Committee.
20. The Committee shall have the **power to refuse membership**, or terminate existing membership, to any person.
21. The Committee shall keep a **written register** of all club members, including guest members. Each club member shall be issued with a membership band, each guest member a dated band and a set of rules.

22. Full club **membership fees** for the 2011 season:  
Family In The Parish: £20 (£32 after 12th June)  
Single In The Parish: £12 (£22 after 12th June)  
Family Outside the Parish: £37 (£47 after 12th June)  
Single Outside the Parish: £22 (£32 after 12th June)

Children three years and under are free. A "Family" shall include two parents and up to six children under 18 living at the same address. Children 18 and over require their own membership if both adults in the family intend to visit the pool (regardless of who actually swims in the pool) Any additional children over the six included above will pay a flat rate of £5 per child

23. The **Parish of Filkins & Broughton Poggs** refers to members with homes within the boundaries of the villages of Filkins and Broughton Poggs.

24. Guest membership shall cost for 2011 season:

**(One day, guest membership) £3 per adult, £2 per child under 18**

Guest membership is ONLY available when accompanied by a full member. The full member must be present at the poolside and complete and sign the guest membership form.

25. Please note that **dogs are not permitted** within the pool area.

26. The **Club Committee** shall consist of a Chairman, Secretary and Treasurer and any other persons elected at the Annual General Meeting of the Club.

27. The Committee shall meet at least twice a year, in addition to the Annual General Meeting, which shall be a meeting open to all club members. All changes to these rules must be ratified at an AGM.

28. Filkins and Broughton Poggs **Parish Council** shall be the final arbiter of any dispute concerning club activities, and reserves the right to change any of these rules at its discretion.

29. **Issues Forms** are available at each of the membership points dealing with membership if you want to report a problem or defective piece of equipment at the Swimming Pool. These can be returned to the Chairman, Ian Grey or to the membership point for forwarding.

30. Emergency Procedures: **In case of emergency** the nearest telephone is located in the village shop, if open or in Bulls Close. (Turn left at the bottom of Rouses Lane approx 20 metres) or alternatively use a mobile phone Dial 999 and request the appropriate service, Fire, Ambulance or Police Please note the swimming pool is located on Rouses Lane postcode GL7 3JE. If the pool needs to be evacuated please assemble at the front of The Village Centre outside the entrance to the village shop and Post Office. All members under 18 will be the responsibility of the adults supervising them. Please then contact one of the committee members to explain the situation:
